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Statements Regarding Applicant and its Principals Response:

After 13 years of investigation and litigation, Competitive Energy Services and Richard Silkman reached a settlement in 2020 with FERC concerning advice they gave to one of their 300 clients concerning a program that FERC terminated in 2008 as fundamentally flawed. In a settlement mediated by a federal magistrate judge, FERC accepted an 85% reduction in its requested penalties (payable over 7 years) and agreed to a permanent resolution of its claims and dismissal of its complaint.
