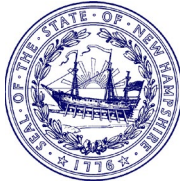

Attorney Chiavara:

Attached is the formal complaint of Community Power Coalition of New Hampshire (CPCNH) against Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (Eversource), filed electronically with the New Hampshire Department of Energy (DOE) on June 13, 2023.

The DOE has accepted the complaint and assigned it complaint number CPT 2023-002. All future correspondence related to the above-captioned complaint at the DOE should reference complaint number CPT 2023-002 and should be submitted electronically via email to proceedings@energy.nh.gov.

Complaints against public utilities filed with the DOE are subject to DOE review in accordance with the provisions of RSA 365:1-4 and Part Puc 204. Pursuant to RSA 365:2, the DOE has attached CPCNH's complaint and accompanying attachments to this letter. The DOE requests that Eversource either:

- 1) Satisfy the matters complained of. This includes making reparation for any injury alleged and ceasing the violation(s) charged in the complaint, as well as taking any other appropriate actions; or
- 2) Provide an answer to the charges in writing within thirty (30) calendar days from today's date, June 23, 2023. Eversource shall advise the DOE and the complainant if it disputes the complaint.

Any submission by the utility in accordance with 1) or 2) above should be sent to the DOE and to the complainant and should include a description of all steps taken by the utility to resolve the complaint.

The DOE has waived the filing of paper copies in this matter and this letter is being sent electronically only.
