This letter serves as acknowledgment that the New Hampshire Department of Energy (DOE) has received your formal complaint against Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy, which was filed electronically with the DOE via email on February 14, 2024.

The DOE has waived the filing of paper copies, accepted your complaint, and assigned it complaint number CPT 2024-004. All future correspondence related to your complaint at the DOE should reference complaint number CPT 2024-004 and should be emailed to proceedings@energy.nh.gov.

Complaints against public utilities filed with the DOE are subject to DOE review in accordance with the provisions of RSA 365:1-4. The DOE will forward a copy of your complaint to the public utility complained of and will require the utility to satisfy matters in the complaint or answer the charges in writing. If the utility makes reparation for any injury alleged, ceases the violation(s) charged in the complaint, and notifies the DOE of that fact before the time allowed to answer the complaint, the DOE will not be required to take any further action. RSA 365:3.

If the charges are not satisfied as provided in RSA 365:3, and it appears to the DOE that there are reasonable grounds therefor, the DOE will investigate the charges pursuant to RSA 365:4.

The DOE will inform you once it has completed review of your complaint in accordance with the provisions of RSA 365:1-4. Once DOE review is complete, if you are not satisfied with the disposition of your complaint, then you may petition the Public

Utilities Commission to resolve the matter through an adjudicative proceeding pursuant to RSA 365:4.

The DOE will notify you of its disposition of your complaint in due course.
