


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1476 Public of the State of NH 38 Hi Line

LICENSE

WHEREAS, the Public Utilities Commission of The State of New Hampshire by its Order No. 10,497, dated February 1, 1972, has found that the granting by The State of New Hampshire of a license to Concord Electric Company, a New Hampshire corporation ("Company"), to construct and maintain an electric transmission line across the Merrimack River and certain lands owned by The State of New Hampshire in Concord, in Merrimack County, upon certain terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, will be consistent with the public interest and will not substantially affect the public rights in such River and lands;

WHEREAS, Company and the State Department of Public Works and Highways have agreed upon a course and width of a right of way for such line, and also on the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth;

NOW THEREFORE, The State of New Hampshire ("The State") does hereby grant to Company a license to construct and maintain, operate, patrol, build and rebuild a pole line with crossarms and subsurface lines, facilities and other appurtenances for the transmission of electric energy and intelligence (herein called said "pole line") on and along the course hereinafter described, crossing the Merrimack River and through certain lands owned by The State lying between the western boundary of land of The State at or near said River and the eastern boundary of land of the State at East Side Drive in said Concord.

The approximate course of said pole line is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on said westerly boundary line, said point being eleven hundred eighty (1180) feet, more or less, southerly of Station 66 + 05, more or less, as shown on a plan by The State of New Hampshire Highway Department of the proposed East-West Highway marked "Preliminary Plans, dated June 19, 1967, Concord P-4809, Sheet 1 of 6," thence S 67° E four hundred thirty-five (435) feet, more or less, to a point; thence S 35° E three hundred forty (340) feet, more or less, to a point; thence S 87° E four hundred ten (410) feet, more or less, to a point; thence N 34° E three hundred forty (340) feet, more or less, to a point; thence N 87° 15' E five hundred fifty (550) feet, more or less, to a point; thence N 72° 15' E four hundred (400) feet, more or less, to a point; thence N 59° 20' E thirteen hundred ninety (1390) feet, more or less, to a point; thence N 68° E two hundred thirty six (236) feet, more or less, to a point of intersection of two courses; thence, one course, continuing N 72° E one hundred ten (110) feet, more or less to said easterly boundary line at said East Side Drive; and the other course continuing from said point of intersection N 46° 30' E one hundred sixty-five (165) feet, more or less, to said easterly boundary line at said East Side Drive. All bearings and distances are approximate as shown on a Plan by Concord Electric Company, Drawings C-3-1137 and C-3-1137A, dated August 31,1971 (revised March 8, 1972) and March 8, 1972 respectively.

This license shall include the right to clear and keep cleared all trees and other inflammable material, and to remove all structures or obstructions which are now or may hereafter endanger or interfere with the maintenance and operation of said pole line; the right to remove from the premises of The State in the vicinity thereof such trees or parts of trees as in the judgment of Company may interfere with or endanger said lines or their maintenance or operation; and the right to pass and repass over the remaining lands of The State in the exercise of the rights herein granted. Company shall not pay to The State any sum for said license. Company shall file a copy of this license with the Registry of Deeds for Merrimack County.
