Dear Mr. Daigle:

On June 6, 2021, Devonshire Energy's registration to conduct business in the State of New Hampshire expired. As no renewal registration was received within 60 days prior to the registration expiration, Devonshire is no longer authorized to be a Competitive Electric Power Supplier (CEPS) to conduct supplier business in the State of New Hampshire.

Should you have an interest in resuming business as a supplier of electric supply service in New Hampshire, a registration application compliant with N.H. Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2003.01 (electric) must be submitted along with a \$250 application fee. Until such time as a new registration application is received and approved, Devonshire Energy shall not market to, make legally binding offers to, or enroll any New Hampshire customers.

Effective July 1, 2021, regulatory responsibility for competitive retail suppliers and aggregators of electric and natural gas supply transferred from the N.H. Public Utilities Commission to the N.H. Department of Energy.
