4. **Unclear.** En 1400 is not identical with Puc 1400, and in rulemaking terms there are substantive changes from Puc 1400, even if minor, in order to “effectuate the transfer”, such as changing “Commission” to “Department.” Also, Puc 1401.01 defining “pipeline public utility” seems more descriptive than En 1401.01.

5. Short Title: **Rules for Pipeline Public Utilities**

6. (a) Summary of what the rule says and of any proposed amendments:

The new En 1400 rules regarding pipeline public utilities reports, which are proposed by the Department of Energy (Department), are the same as existing Puc 1400 rules, with the En 1400 rules effectuating the transfer of the entirety of these regulatory responsibilities regarding certain reporting from the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) to the Department.

The new En 1400 rules mirror the existing Puc 1400 rules without other modification and, more specifically, apply to reporting by pipeline utilities regarding gas, crude petroleum, refined petroleum products, or combinations of petroleum products in the State.

Unclear. See clarity comment above. The phrase “mirror.. without other modification” is more ambiguous than “the same as” in the 1st paragraph.

6. (b) Brief description of the groups affected:

The En 1400 rules generally apply to any public utility that owns or operates any gas pipeline, including pumping stations, storage depots, and other facilities, for the transportation, distribution, or sale of gas, crude petroleum, refined petroleum products, or combinations of petroleum products.

The proposed rules do not mandate or assign any new, expanded, or modified programs or responsibilities to any political subdivision of the State of New Hampshire, and therefore do not violate Part I, Article 28-a of the N.H. Constitution by necessitating additional local expenditures by a political subdivision.

Adopt En 1400 to read as follows:

CHAPTER En 1400 RULES FOR PIPELINE PUBLIC UTILITIES

PART En 1401 DEFINITIONS

En 1401.01 "Pipeline public utility," "pipeline utility" or "utility" means any "public utility" as defined in RSA 362:2.

En 1401.02 "Department" shall mean the New Hampshire department of energy.

PART En 1402 REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

En 1402.01 Reports to Department.

(a) If deemed necessary by the department to evaluate the safe operation of gas pipelines and to fulfill its authority under RSA 374:3, each utility and any owner or operator of a pipeline facility regulated by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission shall provide the department, upon its request, the results of any tests and summaries of any records required under state or federal law. Such tests and summaries may include but not be limited to operating pressures, welding procedures, construction procedures, incident reporting, and accident reporting, and other practices that relate to the safe operation of pipelines.

(b) Each utility and any owner or operator of a pipeline facility regulated by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission shall file reports with the commission on such forms as the department shall specify as provided in En 1403.

(c) Copies of forms shall be furnished by the department upon request.

PART 1403 FORMS TO BE FILED

En 1403.01 F-22 Information Sheet.

(a) Each utility shall file Form F-22:

(1) Annually; and

(2) Whenever any changes occur to the information included in a utility's current Form F-22 filing.

(b) Each utility shall include on Form F-22 the following:

(1) Name of utility;

(2) Officer's or individual's name, address and e-mail address to receive annual report form (EN Form F-16);

(3) Officer's or individual's name, address and e-mail address to receive the utility assessment invoice;

(4) The names and titles of the principal officers of the company; and

(5) The name, title and signature of the individual who supervised the completion of the form, with date of signature.

En 1403.02 Annual Reporting.

(a) Any owner or operator of a pipeline facility regulated by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission shall, with respect to any such pipeline facility located or to be located in New Hampshire, file with the department:

- (1) Concurrently upon its filing annually, on or before April 30 of each year, a copy of the signed original of the applicable Federal Energy Regulatory Commission annual report form (Form Number 2 or 2A) pertaining to such facility; and
- (2) Concurrently upon its filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, a copy of any application for a certification of public convenience and necessity under the Natural Gas Act, 15 U.S.C. § 717f(c), with respect to any pipeline facility proposed to be located in New Hampshire.
