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1 PROCEEDING 2 PRESIDING OFCR. WIND: Okay. Good 3 morning, everybody. For the record, it is 4 10:02 a.m., on October 4th. We are in Hearing 5 Room A. We have moved across the hall from 6 Hearing Room B, because the larger hearing room 7 was available. We are here for a public comment 8 hearing on the Public Utilities Commission and 9 the Department of Energy's Chapter 600 rules, 10 which are proposed, at least for the Public 11 Utilities Commission, for readoption. And Attorney Harmon will introduce the DOE's section 12 13 shortly. 14 However, these rules sets, when taken 15 together, are not intended to substantively 16 change the existing rules. Rather, they are 17 intended to reflect the division of regulatory 18 responsibilities between the Commission and the 19 Department of Energy following the establishment 20 of the Department July of 2021. 21 My name is Eric Wind. I'm a Senior 2.2 Advisor at the Commission. I will serve as 23 Designee for the Chairman of the Commission for 24 this hearing. This hearing occurs in Commission

1 Docket DRM 23-082. 2 Attorney Harmon. 3 PRESIDING OFCR. HARMON: Thank you. 4 Andrew Harmon, Hearing Examiner with the 5 Department of Energy, serving as the Designee of 6 the Commissioner for the Department of Energy. 7 The Department is here to receive 8 comments on the Department's proposed new Energy 600 rules, as well as the 700s. And it is 9 10 correct, our new -- our rules are new. But it is 11 correct that they are not intended to 12 substantively change the existing rules, and 13 instead reflect the division of regulatory 14 responsibilities. 15 Thank you. 16 PRESIDING OFCR. WIND: Okay. Thank 17 you. 18 This joint public comment hearing, 19 we're going to separate these into two separate 20 hearings, 600 and 700. So, my notes are a little 21 inaccurate. So, let's just go ahead and go 2.2 around the room to take comments. I will go 23 through the list of everyone that has signed up 24 as being interested in speaking or potentially

1 interested in speaking. And we will hear 2 comments on both the PUC and the DOE 600 rules at 3 this time. They don't need to be segregated into 4 specific comments on the PUC versus DOE rules. Ι 5 think we're more than comfortable hearing 6 comments in total. 7 PRESIDING OFCR. HARMON: Sure. 8 PRESIDING OFCR. WIND: So, let's begin 9 with Attorney Chiavara. Do you have comments on 10 this rule set? 11 MS. CHIAVARA: Sorry. These were the 600 rules? 12 PRESIDING OFCR. WIND: Yes. 13 MS. CHIAVARA: PUC -- for the PUC 600 14 rules or DOE 600 rules? 15 16 PRESIDING OFCR. HARMON: We're doing 17 them together. 18 MS. CHIAVARA: Okay. 19 PRESIDING OFCR. HARMON: So, if you 20 have any comments on either, we're happy to take 21 them now. 2.2 MS. CHIAVARA: Okay. Great. Thank 23 you. 24 I only had a couple of very minor

1 There are some references to "reports", things. 2 I believe these are in the DOE's rules, referring to the E-5 Accident Report, E-15 Pressure Report, 3 4 E-16 for complaints, E-17 for hydrants, E-18 for 5 service interruptions, all refer to updated new 6 forms from 2023, one in April and the rest in 7 June, but they link to much older documents. So, 8 the newer forms can't be found. And, so, those 9 links need to be updated. 10 PRESIDING OFCR. HARMON: Okay. And we 11 did have some debate over what would be the best 12 way to do that when we discussed that with OLS, 13 and quite wisely went with what OLS would think 14 would be great. 15 And, so, we needed to reflect that the 16 forms are updated in -- consistent with the way 17 they'll be referenced in these rules. They are 18 not live right now, because we don't want someone 19 using rules that aren't in effect yet. 20 MS. CHIAVARA: Sure. 21 PRESIDING OFCR. HARMON: So, I 2.2 appreciate that comment. And I can say that we 23 didn't make substantive changes to the forms. 24 So, to the extent anybody would have a follow-up

1 question about whether they would see the forms, 2 in terms of substance, you see them already. 3 MS. CHIAVARA: Okay. PRESIDING OFCR. HARMON: And I hope 4 5 that helps. 6 MS. CHIAVARA: And we're eager to be 7 sure we're using the right forms. PRESIDING OFCR. HARMON: 8 Sure. 9 MS. CHIAVARA: Then, the one substantive issue I had, it's also relatively 10 minor, the current rules require calibration of 11 12 meters on a 10-year cycle for the five-eighths 13 inch meters, and every four years for 14 three-quarter and one-inch meters. The new -- there was a desire to have 15 16 the meter testing requirements parallel with the 17 manufacturer's requirements. And, so, I just 18 wanted to put that forward for consideration as 19 well. 20 Thank you. 21 PRESIDING OFCR. HARMON: I appreciate 2.2 that. And we did receive a written comment on 23 that. And, so, we will be internally discussing 24 that. I would be deferring, of course, to our

1 technical folks on that, at least initially. But 2 that is something that we've received some 3 information on that ought to help us consider it. MS. CHIAVARA: Great. That's all I 4 5 have. 6 PRESIDING OFCR. HARMON: Great. 7 PRESIDING OFCR. WIND: Okay. Attorney 8 Brown. 9 MS, BROWN: Good morning. Thank you 10 very much for holding this public comment 11 hearing. 12 The only issue that I also wanted to 13 echo, which I understand that two other 14 companies, including Eversource, or Aquarion, and 15 maybe Lakes Region have expressed, is with 16 respect to Puc 605.04, and the "Test Schedules 17 for Meters", in that that chart out to be 18 modified to reflect the manufacturer's 19 recommendations. And, so, I will put that in 20 writing by the deadline. 21 And I have no other substantive 2.2 comments on the 600 rules for DOE or PUC. Thank 23 you. 24 PRESIDING OFCR. HARMON: Thank you.

1 PRESIDING OFCR. WIND: And just for clarity, Attorney Brown, that was the DOE's 2 605.04? 3 4 MS, BROWN: Thank you for picking up on 5 that. I said "Puc", and, in fact, you're 6 deleting it. So, yes. It would pertain to, in 7 addition, to DOE. Thank you for that clarification. 8 9 PRESIDING OFCR. WIND: Yes. Thank you. 10 All right. Ms. King or Ms. Diggins, 11 would Pennichuck like to comment on the 600 rule 12 set? 13 MS. KING: I have nothing at this time. 14 Oh, sorry. 15 PRESIDING OFCR. WIND: And I'm sorry. Good morning. Welcome. I'm not familiar with 16 17 either of you. So, welcome. Good morning. 18 MS. KING: Good morning. 19 MS. DIGGINS: Good morning. 20 PRESIDING OFCR. WIND: Mr. Laflamme, 21 you did not sign up to speak. You have no 2.2 comments as well? 23 MR. LAFLAMME: No comments. PRESIDING OFCR. WIND: Okay. 24 Then, we

1	will close this public comment hearing on the PUC
2	and DOE Chapter 600 rules.
