# Frequently Asked Questions Renewable Energy Fund Fiscal Year 2022 September 3, 2021

### What were the Alternative Compliance Payment (ACP) revenues received for RPS compliance year 2020?

ACP revenues for RPS compliance year 2020 were approximately \$4.8 million.

## The August 30, 2021 letter approved preliminary program allocations. When does the Department of Energy (Department) anticipate allocating additional funding to programs?

The Department anticipates approving additional funding to rebate programs after the RPS Compliance filings (i.e., E-2500 reports) for 2020 are fully reconciled and the Department's permanent Commissioner is appointed.

## When does the Department plan to issue Requests for Proposals (RFPs) for the Non-Residential Grant Program and the Low and Moderate Income Community Solar grant program?

RFPs will be issued by the Department after the RPS Compliance filings for 2020 are fully reconciled and after additional funding allocations are approved.

#### Are the rebate programs open to new applications?

Yes, all four rebate programs are now open for new applications.

#### Are there new rebate application forms?

With the transition of the Renewable Energy Fund from the Public Utilities Commission to the Department, all rebate application forms have been updated to reflect the new agency name, phone number, and applicable email address. The Department strongly encourages all applicants for new projects to use the updated Step 1 application form and all applicants for payment after September 3, 2021 to use the updated Step 2 application form for the applicable rebate program.
