New Hampshire Impact Assessment Consultant

To Prospective Proposers:

The New Hampshire Department of Energy has modified the Request for Proposals as follows:

Paragraph No. 9 on Page 13 is modified to read: “The selected consultant shall be required to submit a Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN), Employer Identification Number (EIN) or Social Security Number, and a Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS) number, and to register as a vendor with the State of New Hampshire.”

Paragraph No. 10 on Pages 13-14 is modified to read: “The terms and conditions set forth in the State’s Form P-37 (version 12/11/2019) “Agreement, General Provisions” (General Provisions) for contracts, attached hereto as Appendix A, shall apply to the contract to be entered into with the winning proposer. In addition, each contract shall be supplemented by three exhibits: Exhibit A will include any special provisions, including any provisions necessitated by federal contracting requirements associated with ARP funds and any modifications to the General Provisions regarding insurance coverage and other matters; Exhibit B will set forth in detail the Scope of Services; and Exhibit C will set forth in detail the price limitation, the source of payment (ARP funds), and any preconditions to payment.”

On Page 14, a new Paragraph No. 16 is inserted following Paragraph No. 15 to read: “The contract shall be funded using ARP funds. As a consequence, the consultant and any subcontractors must familiarize themselves with federal procurement, contracting, and employment practices associated with contracts procured using ARP funds, some of which will be incorporated as applicable into the State’s Form P-37 on Exhibit A.”
