Qualified project manager) it mentions the use of a qualified general contractor. To be more specific, are they talking about the use of an engineer to oversee the project? Alternatively, could we use a contractor that has done similar work to what we are looking to have done?</p> | <p>It is not an eligibility requirement that the project manager be an engineer nor that there be an engineer on the project management team. Scoring will be based upon the qualifications and experience of the project manager and their team, including education and professional affiliations; consequently, an engineering background would tend to increase a score. Likewise, scoring will be based upon experience with similar energy efficiency projects; consequently, experience with similar projects would tend to increase a score. Ultimately, the overall score for this criterion will be based upon a combination of these factors taking into account all key personnel.</p> |
