**Electric Renewable Portfolio Standard
Adjustment to Renewable Portfolio Standard 2024 Class III Requirement**

Summary Following December 20, 2024, Stakeholder Session

On November 22, 2024, the Department of Energy (“Department”) issued an Order of Notice initiating a proceeding to evaluate whether a sufficient supply of Class III (Existing Biomass/Methane) renewable energy certificates (RECs) will be available for New Hampshire electricity providers to comply with the New Hampshire’s Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS) requirements under RSA Chapter 362-F for the 2024 compliance year and the appropriate adjustment, if any, to the obligation for the 2024 compliance year.

A recorded virtual stakeholder session was held on December 19, 2024. During the session the following individuals provided comments:
