The En 1400 rules also simplify the definitions of utilities by retaining the reference to RSA 362:2, but omitting any paraphrasing of the statute. The new En 1400 rules otherwise retain the provisions in the existing Puc 1400 rules and apply to reporting by pipeline utilities regarding gas, crude petroleum, refined petroleum products, or combinations of petroleum products in the State.
