Enclosed please find a Request for Fiscal Impact Statement regarding the En 800 rules entitled, "Underground Utility Damage Program," of the Department of Energy (the Department). Also enclosed for your review is a copy of the Initial Proposal for adoption of Chapter En 800, as approved by the Commissioner of the Department on February 8, 2024.
