

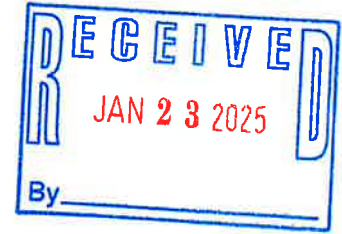

License or Permit Bond

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, **Viridian Energy, LLC**, as Principal, and **Federal Insurance Company** a IN Corporation, and authorized to do business in **New Hampshire** as Surety are held and firmly bound to **Public Utility Commission, State of New Hampshire** as Obligee, in the sum of **One Hundred Thousand and No/100 (\$100,000.00)** for which sum, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, jointly and severally, by the presents.

THE CONDITIONS OF THIS OBLIGATION ARE SUCH, That WHEREAS, the principal has made application to be granted a license or permit to do business to operate as an electric supplier pursuant to New Hampshire Public Utility Commission rules and regulations as defined in PUC 2003.03.

NOW, THEREFORE, if the said Principal shall faithfully comply with all ordinances, rules and regulations which have been or may hereafter be in force concerning said License or Permit, and shall save and keep harmless the obligee from all loss or damage with it may sustain or for which it may become liable on account of the issuance of said License or Permit to the Principal, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this bond shall be **June 1, 2025** and shall be continuous until canceled as herein stated. The bond may not be canceled prior to June 1, 2026. Following June 1, 2026, this bond may be canceled by either the Surety or the Obligee. To cancel this bond, the Surety or the Obligee shall provide at least sixty (60) days prior written notice to the non-terminating party via certified mail. However, to comply with PUC 2003.03 (a)(5), upon cancellation, this bond will remain in place (non-cancellation period) having a 6 month extended claims, draws, or demand period.

The New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission may draw upon this financial security instrument if and when the Company has failed to make required payment(s) and/or payment arrangements in accordance with the terms and conditions of an order issued by the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission.
