## Electric Aggregator Assessment Exemption Claim Form

Aggregators of electric load earning less than \$10,000 in gross revenue in New Hampshire during the January 1 through December 31 calendar year may be eligible for an exemption<sup>1</sup> from the annual assessment.

If you believe you are eligible for this exemption, complete and submit the exemption assessment claim form below.

Exemption claim forms may not be submitted before July 1 and must be submitted no later than July 20 of the same year for which the exemption is requested.
